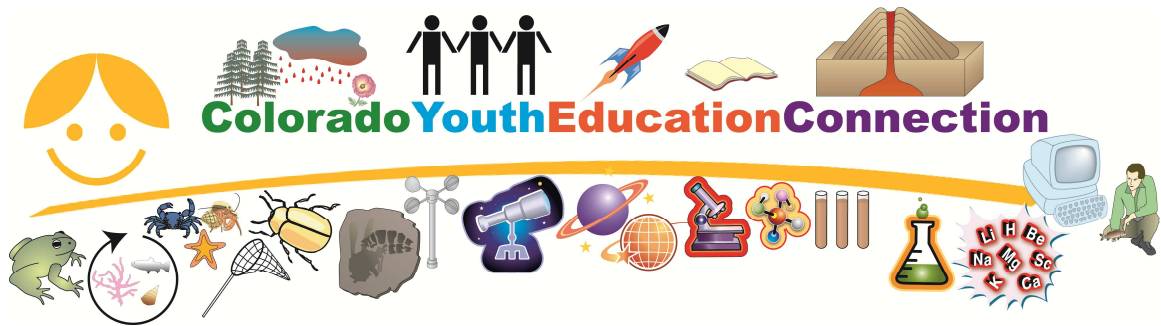

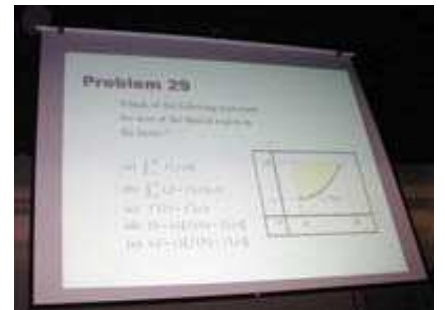

- Direct support to classroom teachers



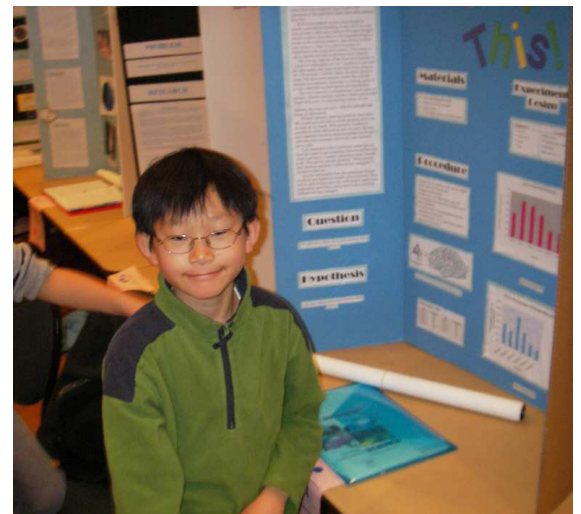
